- SB 71
Provides that Oregon Health Authority establish by rule time frame within which pharmacies shall electronically report to authority information under prescription monitoring program.
- SB 72 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue
Increases fees to take nursing examination and renew nursing license.
- SB 132 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
Expands crime of assault in third degree to include physical injury to health care provider in hospital.
- SB 146
Modifies definition of small employer to permit in-state employers with out-of-state employees to qualify as small employers.
- SB 564
Specifies that personally identifiable information may not be reported to Oregon Health Authority for purposes related to collecting data related to cancer and benign tumors of brain and central nervous system.
