SB 121

Authorizes electors in affected territory to propose plan for abating health hazard other than annexation of territory or extraterritorial extension of city or district services to territory.

Work Session

SJM 4

Urges Congress to enact legislation to update 42 C.F.R. part 2 to allow health care providers for same patient to share treatment information while maintaining appropriate levels of confidentiality and protections against disclosure.

SB 146

Modifies definition of small employer to permit in-state employers with out-of-state employees to qualify as small employers.

SB 228

Increases fees and fee limits for registering tanning devices and X-ray machines and issuing specific licenses for sources of radiation.

SB 505

Requires, from October 1 through March 1 of each year, each hospital in this state to make offer to each patient of hospital who is 65 years of age or older to immunize patient against influenza virus.

Public Hearing

SB 663

Changes governmental framework for conducting public health activities in this state and for providing public health services to residents of this state.
