HB 2419 A

Modifies definition of "health care interpreter" and revises membership of Oregon Council on Health Care Interpreters.

HB 2638

Permits medical assistance recipients and coordinated care organizations to use Oregon Prescription Drug Program.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2024 A

Directs Oregon Health Authority, in consultation with coordinated care organizations and dental care organizations in this state, to certify certain health workers to provide early childhood basic preventive dental services.

HB 2876 A

Prohibits health care facility from allowing person without certain qualifications to practice surgical technology.

HB 3378 A

Requires hospital to adopt written discharge policies.

HB 3464 A

Requires Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules prescribing time frames within which pregnant medical assistance recipient receives dental services and to adopt procedure to ensure that pregnant medical assistance recipient who is not enrolled in managed care organization receives dental screening within specified time frame.
