- SB 213 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits  
Requires Early Learning Council to develop metrics for funding Early Learning Hubs.
- SB 48 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits  
Extends sunset for tax credit for employer-provided dependent care assistance.
- SB 40 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits  
Extends sunset for tax credit for child with disability.
- SB 43 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits  
Extends sunset for additional personal exemption credit for taxpayer with severe disability.
- SB 729 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits  
Creates income tax credit for adopting children from foster system.
- SB 760 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits  
Increases, for purposes of tax credit allowed for crop donation, percentage of wholesale price allowed as amount of credit.

#### Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 710  
Requires state health plans, health insurers, health care providers or health care clearinghouses to provide, upon request, one copy of individually identifiable health information free of charge to individual, or to specified representative, when individual is requesting Social Security disability benefits or contesting denial of Social Security disability benefits.
