SB 592

Repeals law that prevents local governments from imposing conditions on approved permits that effectively establish sales price for residential development or limit purchase to class or group of purchasers.

- **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means 787 ** SB Establishes Task Force on Mental Health Care and Treatment to develop detailed changes to statewide system of mental health care and treatment.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Task Force on Effective Mental Health Treatment for purpose of studying effectiveness of mental health treatment available in Oregon.

SB 840

Authorizes licensed independent practitioner to initiate or approve prehearing detention in hospital or nonhospital facility of person who is subject of civil commitment proceedings.
