Public Hearing

- SB 763 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for mental health programs.
- SB 787 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on Mental Health Care and Treatment to develop detailed changes to statewide system of mental health care and treatment.
- SB 831
Requires coordinated care organization to employ or contract with clinical mental health professionals to provide mental health care and treatment to members of organization.
- SB 832
Requires Oregon Health Authority to provide grants for integrating mental health and physical health services to coordinated care organizations that meet standards prescribed by authority.
- SB 834 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on Effective Mental Health Treatment for purpose of studying effectiveness of mental health treatment available in Oregon.
- SB 840
Authorizes licensed independent practitioner to initiate or approve prehearing detention in hospital or nonhospital facility of person who is subject of civil commitment proceedings.

Work Session

- SB 222 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
Extends sunset on provision authorizing Department of Human Services to appear as party in juvenile court proceeding without appearance of Attorney General.
- SB 710
Requires state health plans, health insurers, health care providers or health care clearinghouses to provide, upon request, one copy of individually identifiable health information free of charge to individual, or to specified representative, when individual is requesting Social Security disability benefits or contesting denial of Social Security disability benefits.
