- SB 632 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/14/15 AGENDA: Directs Department of Human Services to establish two pilot programs in rural and urban regions of this state to improve quality and effectiveness of foster care for children and wards placed in legal custody of department for care, placement and supervision.
- SB 741
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/14/15 AGENDA: Directs Department of Human Services to adopt administrative rules for home studies and placement reports in adoption proceedings that require that equal consideration be given to relatives and current caretakers as prospective adoptive parents, and that greater consideration be given to relatives and current caretakers as compared to other persons who are not relatives or current caretakers.
- SB 760 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/14/15 AGENDA: Increases, for purposes of tax credit allowed for crop donation, percentage of wholesale price allowed as amount of credit.
- SB 226
Requires Department of Human Services to report to Legislative Assembly concerning needed legislative changes by September 1, 2015.
- SB 444
Directs Housing and Community Services Department to submit report related to housing stabilization programs to interim legislative committees no later than July 1, 2016.
- SB 629
Establishes Oregon Right to Rest Act.
- SB 710
Requires state health plans, health insurers, health care providers or health care clearinghouses to provide, upon request, one copy of individually identifiable health information free of charge to individual, or to specified representative, when individual is requesting Social Security disability benefits or contesting denial of Social Security disability benefits.

SB 774

Creates task force to investigate expanding authority of Home Care Commission to provide services to home care workers.

SB 592

Repeals law that prevents local governments from imposing conditions on approved permits that effectively establish sales price for residential development or limit purchase to class or group of purchasers.
