Work Session

- SB 226
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/16/15 AGENDA: Requires Department of Human Services to report to Legislative Assembly concerning needed legislative changes by September 1, 2015.
- SB 629
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/16/15 AGENDA: Establishes Oregon Right to Rest Act.
- SB 774
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/16/15 AGENDA: Creates task force to investigate expanding authority of Home Care Commission to provide services to home care workers.

Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 592
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/16/15 AGENDA: Repeals law that prevents local governments from imposing conditions on approved permits that effectively establish sales price for residential development or limit purchase to class or group of purchasers.

Work Session

- SB 307
Imposes new requirements on continuing care retirement communities and residential facilities.
- SB 465
Specifies duties and liabilities of community mental health program with respect to commitment proceedings initiated for individuals with mental illness.
- SB 832
Requires Oregon Health Authority to provide grants for integrating mental health and physical health services to coordinated care organizations that meet standards prescribed by authority.
