SB 356

Modifies sentence that court is required to impose when certain persons are convicted of felony driving under the influence of intoxicants.

Increases fees for driving while under influence of intoxicants screening interview and diagnostic assessment.

SB 398 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue

Requires providers of ignition interlock devices to notify court that required device to be installed of any negative reports downloaded from ignition interlock device.

Possible Work Session

HB 2700

Authorizes court, as part of settlement or judgment in class action, to approve process for payment of damages.
