SB 161 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue

Authorizes county tax collector to transmit electronic notices of warrants for delinquent taxes on business personal property to Secretary of State for filing in Uniform Commercial Code (UCC) system.

SB 358

Modifies time within which state agency that adopts rule must submit copy of adopted rule to Legislative Counsel for review.

SB 402

Permits affiant in small estate to open one or more deposit accounts in financial institution with funds of decedent upon which to withdraw funds to pay certain claims and expenses.

### **Work Session**

SB 367

Makes purchaser at execution sale of real property in planned community or condominium community jointly and severally liable with title holder for assessments imposed against real property during redemption period.

SB 381

Directs Board of Governors of Oregon State Bar to establish position on board for active member of bar who maintains principal office outside State of Oregon.

SB 471

Requires court to appoint legal counsel for respondent or protected person in protective proceeding under certain circumstances.
