Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 3

Creates crime of endangering person protected by Family Abuse Prevention Act restraining order.

SB 364

Requires court to use current classification of marijuana offenses when determining if person is eligible for order setting aside conviction.

HB 2335

Revises definition of "enter or remain unlawfully" for purposes of crimes of burglary and criminal trespass.

HB 2433

Provides that electronically filed criminal citation may be of different format or size than uniform citation.

HB 2372

Requires that police officer be certified by Department of Public Safety Standards and Training rather than Board on Public Safety Standards and Training before officer may request urine test of person arrested for offense of driving while under influence of intoxicants.

HB 2380

Authorizes court in post-conviction relief proceeding, upon joint motion of parties, to vacate judgment or order and remand proceeding to circuit court to reconsider judgment or order.

SB 384

Requires judge to appoint certified shorthand reporter for aggravated murder proceedings.
