SB 224

Exempts Oregon Health Authority and Department of Human Services from certain provisions relating to acquiring, holding or disposing of real property or equitable interest in real property or in mineral or geothermal resource right.

SB 694

SB

Allows operators of motorcycles and mopeds to pass vehicles in same lane during traffic jams or slowdowns. 788

Requires petitioners in family law proceedings to disclose existence of certain protective orders entered against parties in petitions for marital annulment, dissolution or separation.

SB 822

Directs presiding judge of each judicial district to ensure all grand jury proceedings except for deliberations and voting are recorded verbatim.

SB 849
