HB 2173

Requires Secretary of State, as State Auditor, to report fraud or other violations of criminal law to appropriate law enforcement agency, regardless of source of moneys involved in fraud or violation.

HB 3156 A

Changes circumstances under which enforcement of child support order may be suspended.

HB 3158

Removes time limitation on judgments subject to laws regarding multiple child support judgments.

HB 3159 A

Creates debt in favor of state for dishonored checks for support that are presented by other issuer on behalf of obligor or withholder.
