HB 2339

Requires court to appoint interpreter and provide appropriate assistive communication device when necessary for crime victim who seeks to exercise certain constitutional rights in open court.

HB 2340 A

Limits personal information that may be included in certain judgments, orders and other court documents.

HB 2349 A

Requires petition for appointment of professional fiduciary to include information regarding investment credentials, licensing, fees, method for assessing or charging fees and acknowledgment that professional fiduciary will make all investments of client assets in accordance with certain investment standards.

HB 2908 A

Brings Oregon law into compliance with federal Preventing Sex Trafficking and Strengthening Families Act of 2014.

HB 3014

Changes definition of "grandparent" in laws pertaining to notice to grandparents of juvenile dependency hearings regarding grandchildren, and that authorize grandparents to request visitation or other contact or communication with grandchildren when grandchildren are in legal custody of Department of Human Services.
