Public Hearing and Work Session

- HB 2310 A
Allows Department of Corrections inmates to receive credit for time served for presentence incarceration after arrest for certain crimes related to sentencing crime.
- HB 3347 A
Modifies definition of "person with mental illness" as used in civil commitment statutes.
- HB 3365 A
Modifies crime of displaying obscene materials to minors.
- HB 3399 A
Requires justice court or municipal court to record criminal proceedings.

Work Session

- HB 2356 A** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Creates crime of invasion of personal privacy in the first degree.
- HB 2557 A
Creates process by which person found guilty except for insanity can apply to court for order setting aside judgment of guilty except for insanity.
- HB 2596 A
Provides that person who records another person's intimate areas commits crime of invasion of personal privacy.
