HB 3015

Adds options for name after marriage or after entering into registered domestic partnership.

HB 3236 A

Limits enforceability of noncompetition agreement to 18 months.

HB 3399 A

Requires justice court or municipal court to record criminal proceedings.

HB 3452 A

Provides that contract to allow use of property or facilities by nonprofit organization providing services to youths or by educational provider may not require individual participant to indemnify property owner for damages not caused by individual participant.

HB 3498 A

Provides that applicant for registration by State Marine Board as outfitter and guide may not have been convicted of certain offenses preceding application.

HB 3524 A

Requires state, when selling or disposing of real property, to grant right of first refusal to developers of affordable housing.

HB 2333 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Clarifies that certain statutes of limitation are tolled if person entitled to bring action is child or is insane.

HB 2357 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/27/2015 AGENDA: Modifies certain law enforcement defenses applicable to certain firearms-related crimes.

HB 2365 A

Updates and revises adoption and readoption laws to provide clarification and consistency.

HB 2366 A

Modifies filing, motion and certificate fees in adoption proceedings.

- HB 3093 A
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/27/2015 AGENDA: Provides persons licensed to carry concealed handgun in another state with protections provided to persons with Oregon concealed handgun license if other state recognizes Oregon concealed handgun licenses and requires handgun competency to obtain license that is similar to requirement in Oregon.
- HB 3164 A
Specifies conditions under which farm implement supplier has good cause to terminate, cancel or not renew retailer agreement, or to cause change in competitive circumstances for retailer.
- HB 3347 A
Modifies definition of "person with mental illness" as used in civil commitment statutes.
