Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2225 A

Authorizes circuit court judge to authorize execution of search warrant outside judicial district of court for search related to certain offenses involving victim 65 years of age or older.

HB 2227

Exempts from definition of "sexual abuse" consensual sexual contact between elderly person and facility employee who is also spouse of elderly person.

HB 3206 A

Permits any person convicted of aggravated murder or felony with relevant DNA evidence to file motion for DNA testing.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2845 A

Establishes conditions under which person may sell guaranteed asset protection waiver in connection with sale or lease of motor vehicle.

Work Session

HB 2310 A

Allows Department of Corrections inmates to receive credit for time served for presentence incarceration after arrest for certain crimes related to sentencing crime.

HB 2357 A

Modifies certain law enforcement defenses applicable to certain firearms-related crimes.

HB 3093 A

Provides persons licensed to carry concealed handgun in another state with protections provided to persons with Oregon concealed handgun license if other state recognizes Oregon concealed handgun licenses and requires handgun competency to obtain license that is similar to requirement in Oregon.

HB 3365 A

Modifies crime of displaying obscene materials to minors.

HB 3399 A
Requires justice court or municipal court to record criminal proceedings.

HB 3452 A
Provides that contract to allow use of property or facilities by nonprofit organization providing services to youths or by educational provider may not require individual participant to indemnify property owner for damages not caused by individual participant.
