Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2313 A

Prohibits person under 21 years of age from attempting to purchase, purchasing or acquiring marijuana items, and from entering portion of licensed premises where such persons are prohibited.

HB 2704 A

Creates exemption to prohibition on recording conversations for person openly recording law enforcement officer while officer is performing official duties in public place.

HB 3469

Increases penalty for crime of strangulation when committed knowing victim was pregnant.

Work Session

HB 2571 A

Requires law enforcement agency to establish policies and procedures for use and retention of recordings from cameras worn upon police officer's person to record officer's interactions with members of public.

HB 3040 A

Directs Oregon Law Commission to study and make recommendations for changes to law relating to hearsay in criminal actions involving sex trafficking.

HB 3365 A

Modifies crime of displaying obscene materials to minors.

HB 3468 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Adds threatening to cause physical injury to animal to induce other person to engage in conduct as manner of committing crime of coercion.
