#### Possible Reconsideration and Work Session

HB 2366 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 6/2/2015 AGENDA: Modifies filing, motion and certificate fees in adoption proceedings.

HB 3093 A

Provides persons licensed to carry concealed handgun in another state with protections provided to persons with Oregon concealed handgun license if other state recognizes Oregon concealed handgun licenses and requires handgun competency to obtain license that is similar to requirement in Oregon.

HB 3524 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 6/2/2015 AGENDA: Requires state, when selling or disposing of real property, to grant right of first refusal to developers of affordable housing.

#### Work Session

HB 2313 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 6/2/2015 AGENDA: Prohibits person under 21 years of age from attempting to purchase, purchasing or acquiring marijuana items, and from entering portion of licensed premises where such persons are prohibited.

HB 2704 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 6/2/2015 AGENDA: Creates exemption to prohibition on recording conversations for person openly recording law enforcement officer while officer is performing official duties in public place.

HB 2845 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 6/2/2015 AGENDA: Establishes conditions under which person may sell guaranteed asset protection waiver in connection with sale or lease of motor vehicle.

HB 3040 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 6/2/2015 AGENDA: Directs Oregon Law Commission to study and make recommendations for changes to law relating to hearsay in criminal actions involving sex trafficking.

HB 3399 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 6/2/2015 AGENDA: Requires justice court or municipal court to record criminal proceedings.
