Public Hearing

SCR 7

Recognizes and honors Specialist John Alexander Pelham (1991-2014) for his service to his country.

SB 717

Directs Department of Transportation to erect and maintain Fallen Hero roadside memorial sign for John Pelham.

HB 2763

Removes provision that public officer or employee who leaves position to perform military duty may not, while performing military duty, receive amount of pay entitled to before leave of absence.

SB 531

Removes provision that public officer or employee who leaves position to perform military duty may not, while performing military duty, receive amount of pay entitled to before leave of absence.

SJM 11

Urges Congress to improve and support efforts to bring health care to veterans in rural communities.

SB 92

Directs State Board of Education to develop data collection standards for school districts to collect data on students from military families.

Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 97

Requires reinstatement of home and community-based services for child of military service member upon child's return to state after temporary absence due to parent's military obligation.

SB 408 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Military Department for Oregon Military Museum.

SB 251

Clarifies Department of Veterans' Affairs status and authority as fiduciary and representative payee appointed by United States Department of Veterans Affairs and United States Social Security Administration.

SB 252

Exempts Department of Veterans' Affairs from requirement to request or participate in resolution conference in connection with foreclosure of residential trust deed when department is acting in capacity as beneficiary of loan made by department pursuant to statute.

SB 253

Exempts personally identifiable and contact information of veterans and persons serving on active duty or as reserve members with Armed Forces of United States, National Guard or other reserve component from disclosure as public records when information was obtained by Department of Veterans' Affairs in performance of department's duties and functions.
