Public Hearing

- HB 2426 A
- Establishes statutory authority for technological enhancements to 9-1-1 emergency communications system. HB 2919

Eliminates reporting requirement related to disclosure, at request of law enforcement agency, of call location information of cellular device used to call 9-1-1 or believed to be in possession of individual who is believed to be in emergency situation.

HB 2981

Directs Department of Transportation to erect and maintain Fallen Hero roadside memorial sign for Specialist Mabry James Anders.

HCR 22

Recognizes and honors Army Specialist Taylor Daniel Marks (1989-2009) for his service to his country. HJM 3

Urges Congress to enact legislation requiring stabilization of crude oil prior to transport.

HJM 9

Urges Congress to recognize presumption of service connection for Blue Water Vietnam War veterans exposed to Agent Orange.
