Public Hearing

SB 598

Establishes Task Force on 21st Century Apprenticeship with 14 members appointed by President of Senate, Speaker of House of Representatives and Governor.

SB 809

Requires bidder that submits bid for contract for public works with estimated contract price of \$1 million or more to demonstrate responsibility by belonging to local joint committee whose training agents, in aggregate, employed apprentices for 10 percent or more of hours that training agents' employees worked on contracts in previous calendar year or by showing that bidder employed apprentices for 10 percent or more of hours that bidder semployees worked on contracts during previous calendar y **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

SB 786 **
