SB 555

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/11/2015 AGENDA: Requires bidder that submits bid for contract for public works with estimated contract price of \$1 million or more to demonstrate responsibility by belonging to local joint committee whose training agents, in aggregate, employed apprentices for 10 percent or more of hours that training agents' employees worked on contracts in previous calendar year or by showing that bidder employed apprentices for 10 percent or more of hours that bidder's employees worked on contracts during previous calendar year
