Subject: HB 3225, relating to the safe transport of hazardous materials

HB 3225 directs the Oregon State Fire Marshall (OSFM) to adopt a plan to coordinate response to oil or hazardous materials spills or releases that occur during rail transport. The bill establishes the Oil and Hazardous Material Transportation by Rail Action Fund to receive and account for gifts, grants, donations, endowments, or bequests from any public or private source to carry out the provisions of this bill, and requires OSFM to submit a report by February 1 each year to the Legislative Assembly as an appendix to the Office of Emergency Management's plan pursuant to ORS 401.092.

The measure, the original staff measure summary, a preliminary Joint Committee on Ways and Means staff measure summary, fiscal impact statement, and measure history are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

The -A6 amendment adds a General Fund appropriation of \$365,225 to the Oregon State Police's 2015-17 budget. This funding will allow the Office of the State Fire Marshal to hire a Program Analyst position to coordinate outreach and develop the spill response plan in conjunction with local public safety organizations; and it will provide funding for conducting exercises, training, and support for local public safety organizations.

LFO recommends moving the - 6 amendment into the bill.
