PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5017

- On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 though 26 and delete page 2 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$7,672,625,891 for the State School Fund.
- "SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$327,374,109 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Department of Education for the State School Fund.
- "SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$3,936,407 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of Education from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Education for the State School Fund.
- "SECTION 4. Notwithstanding ORS 327.008 and 327.013, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, the Department of Education:

"(1) May spend up to \$968,000 from the State School Fund for the

- "(2) May spend up to \$1,600,000 from the State School Fund for purposes related to the Oregon Virtual School District.
- "SECTION 5. (1) The Department of Education may not spend more than \$3,921,928,839 from the State School Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015.
- "(2) The Department of Education may not spend more than 8 \$4,082,007,568 from the State School Fund for the fiscal year beginning 9 July 1, 2016.
- "SECTION 6. The amount of \$3,535,581 is transferred from the State
 School Fund to the Local Option Equalization Grants Account created
 in ORS 327.339.
 - "SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015."
