**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 5017**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 26 and delete page 2
2 and insert:

3 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
4 **ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the**
5 **biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount**
6 **of \$7,672,625,891 for the State School Fund.**

7 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
8 **the amount of \$327,374,109 is established for the biennium beginning**
9 **July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-**
10 **tery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic**
11 **Development Fund to the Department of Education for the State**
12 **School Fund.**

13 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
14 **the amount of \$3,936,407 is established for the biennium beginning July**
15 **1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-**
16 **partment of Education from fees, moneys or other revenues, including**
17 **Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds,**
18 **collected or received by the Department of Education for the State**
19 **School Fund.**

20 **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding ORS 327.008 and 327.013, for the**
21 **biennium beginning July 1, 2015, the Department of Education:**

22 **“(1) May spend up to \$968,000 from the State School Fund for the**

1 **contract described in ORS 329.488.**

2 **“(2) May spend up to \$1,600,000 from the State School Fund for**
3 **purposes related to the Oregon Virtual School District.**

4 **“SECTION 5. (1) The Department of Education may not spend more**
5 **than \$3,921,928,839 from the State School Fund for the fiscal year be-**
6 **ginning July 1, 2015.**

7 **“(2) The Department of Education may not spend more than**
8 **\$4,082,007,568 from the State School Fund for the fiscal year beginning**
9 **July 1, 2016.**

10 **“SECTION 6. The amount of \$3,535,581 is transferred from the State**
11 **School Fund to the Local Option Equalization Grants Account created**
12 **in ORS 327.339.**

13 **“SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate**
14 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
15 **declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.”.**
