

Expenditure History + 2015-17 Governor's Budget








2015 - 17 Governor's Budget

#### Investments

- Affordable housing for very low income individuals
- Maintain current funding for Emergency Housing
  Assistance and State Homelessness Assistance programs
- Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) position
- Mortgage Foreclosure Assistance
- Enhanced funding for the Oregon Commission on Voluntary

2015-17 Governor's Budget/Co-Chairs' Framework

- Governor's Budget provides \$15.7 million
  General Fund to Housing and Community
  Services
  - Co-Chair's Budget Framework does not specify an amount specific to the department
  - Co-Chair's Budget Framework also defers decisions on bonding issues
