According to the federal government's own surveys (1), the claim that the single greatest cause of voting problems in the United States is the voter registration system is **false**.

The greatest causes of individuals not registering and not voting are their **lack of interest in politics and candidates** and other reasons that have nothing whatsoever to do with registration or lack of registration.

Requiring automatic registration from government databases risks the integrity of the election process and **improperly shifts the responsibility for registering from the individual to the government**.

There are too many unresolved problems with this bill including the potential to inadvertently register people that do not meet the legal requirements to vote.
