## **SUMMARY**

Modifies definition of "scientifically based research" with respect to evidence-based programs.

## 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to scientifically based research; creating new provisions; and
- 3 amending ORS 182.515.
- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 182.515 is amended to read:
- 6 182.515. As used in this section and ORS 182.525:
- 7 (1) "Agency" means:
- 8 (a) The Department of Corrections;
- 9 (b) The Oregon Youth Authority;
- 10 (c) The Youth Development Division; and
- 11 (d) That part of the Oregon Health Authority that deals with mental 12 health and addiction issues.
- 13 (2) "Cost-effective" means that benefits realized over a reasonable period
- 14 of time are greater than costs, as determined utilizing a cost-benefit analyt-
- 15 ical tool identified by the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission.
- 16 (3) "Evidence-based program" means a program that:
- 17 (a) Incorporates significant and relevant practices based on scientifically
- 18 based research; and
- 19 (b) Is cost-effective.
- 20 (4)(a) "Program" means a treatment or intervention program or service
- 21 that is intended to:

- 1 (A) Reduce the propensity of a person to commit crimes;
- 2 (B) Improve the mental health of a person with the result of reducing the
- 3 likelihood that the person will commit a crime or need emergency mental
- 4 health services; or
- 5 (C) Reduce the propensity of a person who is less than 18 years of age to
- 6 engage in antisocial behavior with the result of reducing the likelihood that
- 7 the person will become a juvenile offender.
- 8 (b) "Program" does not include:
- 9 (A) An educational program or service that an agency is required to provide to meet educational requirements imposed by state law; or
- 11 (B) A program that provides basic medical services.
- 12 (5) "Scientifically based research" means [research that obtains reliable
- 13 and valid knowledge by:] scientific evaluation that is rigorous, inde-
- 14 pendent and credible and includes, at a minimum, scientific evaluation
- 15 **that:**
- [(a) Employing systematic, empirical methods that draw on observation or
- 17 experiment;]
- 18 [(b) Involving rigorous data analyses that are adequate to test the stated
- 19 hypotheses and justify the general conclusions drawn;]
- 20 [(c) Relying on measurements or observational methods that provide reliable
- 21 and valid data across evaluators and observers, across multiple measurements
- 22 and observations and across studies by the same or different investigators;

- 24 [(d) Utilizing randomized controlled trials when possible and
- 25 appropriate.]
- 26 (a) Is conducted independently of any organization that has imple-
- 27 mented, funded or supported a program;
- 28 (b) Includes any individual who was originally enrolled in a program
- 29 regardless of whether the originally enrolled individual completed the
- 30 program; and
  - (c) Is conducted pursuant to an experimental design using rigorous,

3	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 182.515 by section 1 of this
4	2015 Act applies to evidence-based programs implemented on or after
5	the effective date of this 2015 Act.
