SUMMARY

Establishes public policy that Department of Human Services employee whose employment is terminated for violating duty to report abuse is not eligible for reinstatement of employment with department.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to violation of duty to report abuse; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. It is the public policy of this state that an employee of the Department of Human Services who violates the duty to report abuse as mandated by the laws of this state, including but not limited to violation of the duties to report abuse under ORS 124.060, 419B.010, 430.765 or 441.640, and whose employment is terminated for the violation, is not eligible for reinstatement of employment with the department.

SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.
