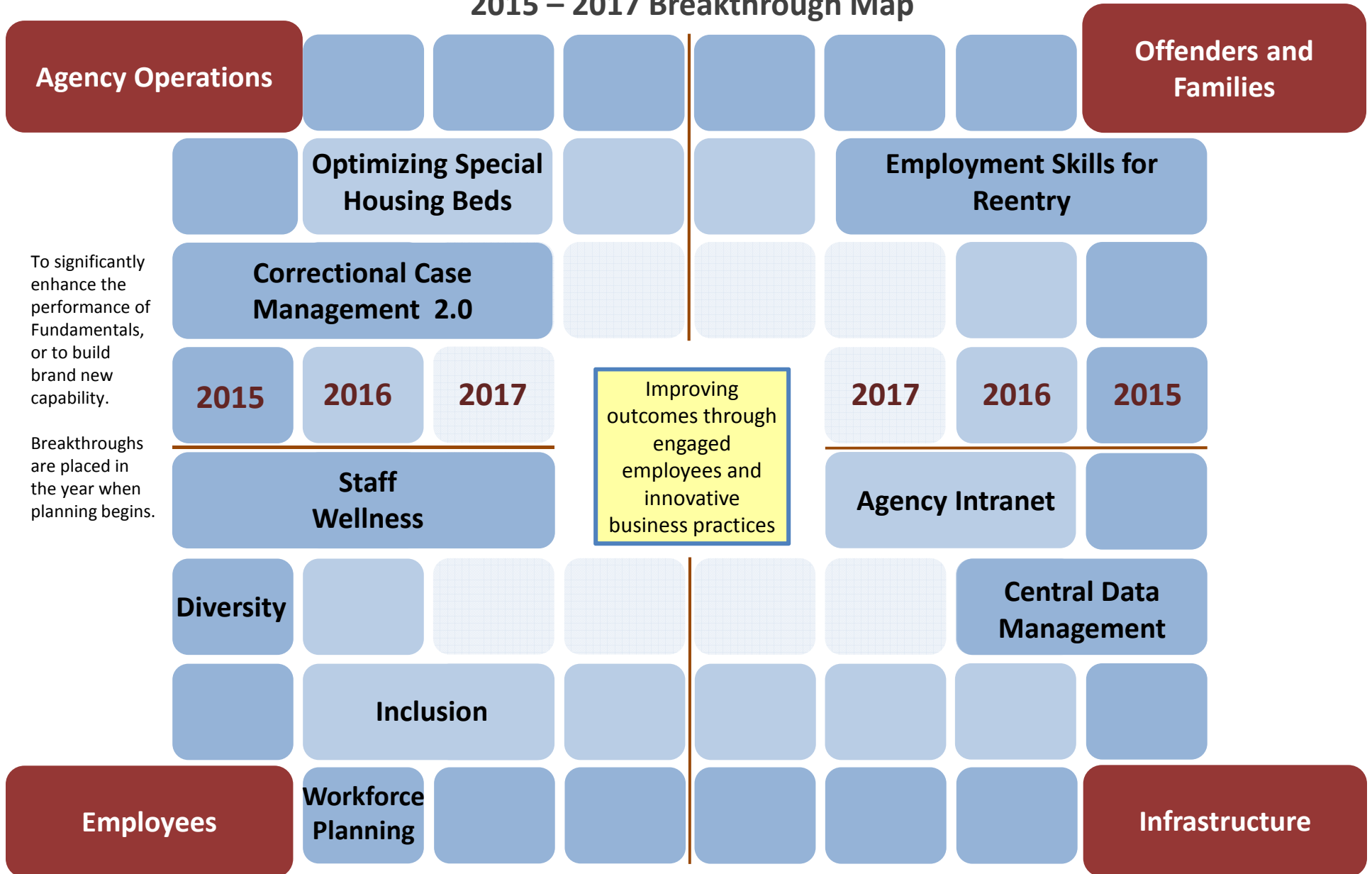

<p><b>SITUATION:</b> We are currently reviewing special housing for best practices. As a result, 1) Currently, there is no evidence based data on what we are doing to determine if segregation is the appropriate method for behavioral change. <i>We do not know the most appropriate number of days an inmate should be in special housing.</i> 2) Isolation has a negative impact on an inmates well being. 3) We have not developed partnerships to determine best practices. 4) Programming is currently inconsistent across the state.</p>
