This letter is a strong effort to encourage your committee to help preserve the funding for the Building Code Division's e-permitting system now in place here in Malheur County and many other jurisdictions across our State as well. The program has proven itself to be very helpful, not only by allowing contractors to purchase permit on a 24-7 basis, but also the tracking of the permits and record keeping. This program provides us with a system to refer back to archival information long after the project has been completed. It is a very useful tool that can be used to accurately track a current project and be used over and over to refer to the past construction of projects when a client wishes to construct an addition or do a remodel. Often having that information can really help speed the permit process along. Also, the easily accessed information is very helpful to code and other governmental officials when making determinations relating to use and occupancy.
