

Not another moment lost to seizures

Mission Statement: The Epilepsy Foundation Northwest leads the fight to stop seizures, find a cure and overcome challenges created by epilepsy.

General Statements: Epilepsy Foundation Northwest (EFNW) is the principal advocate for the epilepsy community in Oregon, Washington, Alaska with support to neighboring Northwest states. Nearly 136,000 people are living with epilepsy or seizure related disorders in the northwest (66,000 WA – 38,000 OR – 7,000 AK – 10,000 MT – 15,000 ID).

The Epilepsy Foundation Northwest is a 501(c) (3) nonprofit organization governed by a volunteer Board of Directors and hosts a medically based Professional Advisory Board. EFNW offices are located in Seattle, Spokane and Portland with community action programs in Anchorage and Tri-Cities, WA.

EFNW is a stand-alone affiliate of the national Epilepsy Foundation, and works closely with the national foundation to develop and implement programs and services for people with epilepsy in the northwest.
