### **BACKGROUND:**

In 2012, Metro embarked on a public-private partnership approach to the construction of a hotel. The overall project is approximately \$200 million, with over \$60% of private investment; the largest public contribution will be from transient lodging taxes paid by guests of the hotel itself. The 2013 Legislature approved \$10 million in lottery bonds to complete the finance plan.
