




- Agency's emerging issues:

Expenditure History + 2015-17 Governor's Budget



Investments

- \$5.0 million General Fund for Specialty Courts
 - Almost fully replaces \$5.2 million Federal Funds shortfall
- \$43.5 million General Fund for Justice Reinvestment grants
 - Adds to \$15.0 million in base budget for \$58.5 million total

Other adjustments

 Shift to General Fund to maintain positions formerly supported by Federal ARRA funds

Criminal Justice Commission 2015-17 Governor's Budget/Revisions





- Appropriation/budget bill corrections:
 - Agency needs an increase of Federal Funds grant revenue and expenditure limitation
 - ▼ Governor's Budget lacks limitation for ongoing federal grants

Criminal Justice Commission 2015-17 Governor's Budget/ Co-Chairs' Framework





- Only one apparent difference:
 - o Implementation of Justice Reinvestment Initiative
 - Governor's Budget provides \$58.5 million General Fund
 - Co-Chairs' Framework provides \$20.0 million General Fund
