Please support HB2231.

Healthcare transformation is moving successfully through partnerships between the service providers, insurance business, government and local communities throughout our state. Partnership with the state has been one key reason for success. The state authorized Coordinated Care Organizations in numerous locales across Oregon.

Each area of the triple aim is vital. Improvement of health, healthcare and costs requires better use of our resources. Redundant, expensive and unnecessary requirements impede our success.

The providers and CCO's accept the state authorization of each CCO to operate. The CCO's should accept the state's authorization of qualified, credentialed providers to contract with the CCO's.

Looking Glass serves behavioral health customers from throughout the entire state. We have treatment programs for children, adults and families with mental health and/or alcohol/drug issues. It costs our agency about \$1,000 and several days of paperwork each time we go through an approval process to contract with a CCO. The process with each CCO is basically the same no significant differences. This is time and money that could be saved by having the Oregon Health Authority provide credentialing and authorization. This will provide more focus on improving the health of our clients, as well as favorably bend the cost curve of the global budget
