Program Description

The Occupational Therapy Licensing Board protects the public by supervising occupational therapy practice; and to assure safe and ethical delivery of occupational therapy services. The Board sets the standards of practice and examines applicants for licensure; issues licenses to qualified applicants; investigates complaints; and takes appropriate disciplinary action when necessary. The Board is 100% Other Funds, through revenue generated from license fees and other miscellaneous sources.

Policy Issues

The agency requests \$61,870 Other Funds to increase FTE of existing position from 0.25 to 0.50 and reclassify the position from an Office Specialist 1 to an Admin Specialist 2. Currently, the Board is supported by the Executive Director (1.00 FTE) and the Office Specialist (0.25 FTE), however, there is not enough “coverage” to keep the Board operating full time and there has been increasing workload as applications, licensure, and discipline have all increased over the past few biennia.
