Just like Oregon voters are rebelling against the iniquities of the Governor, as a majority of voters across the country did in November, so is their political revolt to the Prussian-born wage issues mirrored in SB 454 and HB 2005.

The legislators impacted by this testimony are not doltish. Therefore the remaining logic places the damage and vulnerability to 4 of my 16 employees, due to layoffs from this potential legislation, directly upon purposed political actions.

It is my goal via a current ad campaign against these bills, to show Oregon voters of the destructive intent aimed at thousands more loyal employees and small businesses that want only to be left alone.

The compounded damage for Paid Sick Time to an employer is twice the intent of the bill due to unmentioned replacement labor. But there is no disguising the apathy by the proponents.

it is clear that the artificial compassion advertised as motive for passing SB 454/HB 2005 is a cloak for appearing the liberal donor voting class and dichotomous welfare class on the other end of the economic and specifically, voter spectrum.

This "vulnerability" charade leaves a debris trail of abused, working, "revenue" generating voters and innocent citizens in its wake, of which many are finding other political lifeboats to rescue them.
