WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Increases fees for driving under the influence of intoxicants (DUII) diagnostic assessment and screening interview from \$150 to \$275.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: ORS 813.020 states that, when a person is convicted of DUII, the court shall require defendant to complete a screening interview and treatment program as provided in ORS 813.021. This screening interview determines the appropriate placement for defendant in a treatment program for alcoholism, drug dependency or dependency on inhalants. Defendants are required to pay a fee to Oregon Alcohol and Drug Evaluation and Screening Specialists (ADES) for this interview and diagnostic assessment.

SB 397 amends ORS 813.021 to increase the fee for a screening interview and diagnostic assessment from \$150 to \$275.
