## **BACKGROUND:**

In 2013 the Legislature passed House Bill 2620 which directed the Governor, in coordination with the Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, to develop a plan to align state economic and community development programs with regional priorities. Senate Bill 201 requires the Governor to appoint at least one natural resources alignment coordinator to work with regional solutions teams, natural resource agencies and the Governor to improve the manner that agencies make regulatory decisions and to assist agencies and regional solutions teams in addressing high-priority projects.
