

## **HOUSE BILLS 2050 AND 2381**

Comments to the House Agriculture & Natural Resources Committee by Gil Riddell, Policy Director, Association of Oregon Counties, February 17, 2015.

The Association of Oregon Counties, representing all 36 county governments in the State, fully support the two identical House Bills that:

- Exempt a county from the prohibition against hunting cougars with dogs, if a county referendum or initiative that so provides becomes law; and
- Require the exempted county to notify the Department of Fish & Wildlife of its exemption.

AOC also supports the identical Senate versions, Senate Bills 126 and 453.

These bills permit the local population to choose a policy on hunting that makes sense to them.
