

 - Real-time withholding match during processing.




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Funding of core services

Property Valuation System

- Current challenges:
 - Fragmented and unsupportable technology.
 - Non-industry standards of mass appraisal.
 - Increasing number of properties to appraise with decreasing staffing levels.
 - Lack of an integrated system.
 - No ability to communicate electronically with taxpayers, such as e-file or permit account access.
 - Lack of data analytics.



Property Valuation System

- System benefits:
 - Integrate appraisal technology.
 - More broadly and equally employ appraisal industry standards.
 - Improve customer service.
 - Promote higher degree of confidence in Real Market Value outputs.
 - Provide a stable, long-term IT platform.
 - Increase the time available to focus on the appraisal process.
