The City of Bend opposes SB 414 because it would impose additional

projects for months if not years. Not only that, but they could force local governments to face the additional cost of defending cases in Salem rather than in the local circuit court.

The proposed legislation would require an additional round of a public contracting process, which adds to the cost of the project and adds delay and staff time to the project. The City strongly urges that SB 414 not be advanced.
