Summer Learning Partnership

The Summer Learning Partnership has identified **141 potential sites** for the SL3 Program using the following criteria:

- Over 50% of students qualifying for the Free and Reduced Meal Program, and;
- Low reading scores of 60% not meeting 3rd grade benchmark.



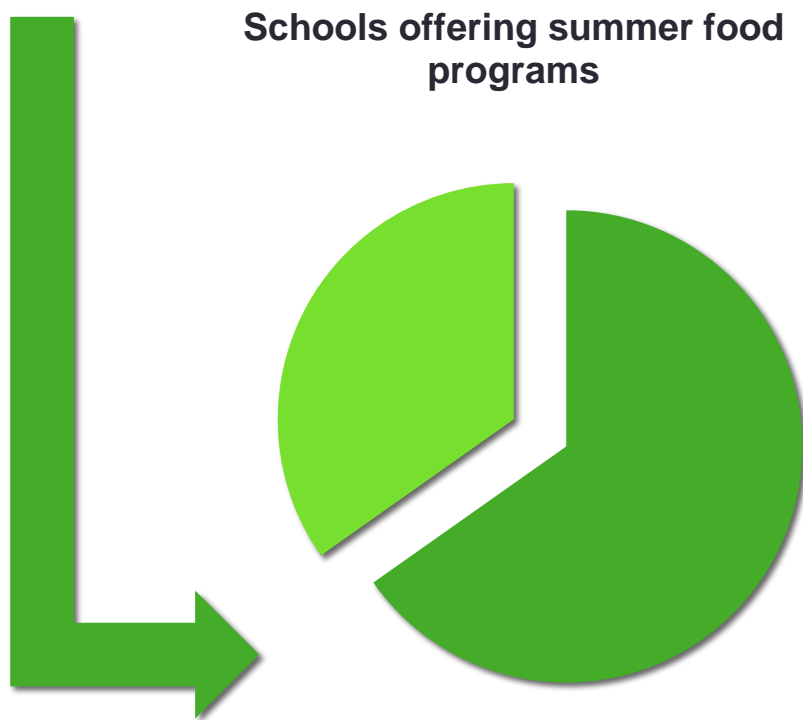
To meet the needs of these 141 sites the Partnership believes it especially beneficial to keep their libraries open during the summer to decrease summer learning loss, feed the minds and bellies of our children, and provide a safe environment in the summer months.



Potential SL3 Expansion

We received 69 potential SL3 surveys. Of these sites:

65.22% of schools do offer summer food programs, **34.78%** do not.

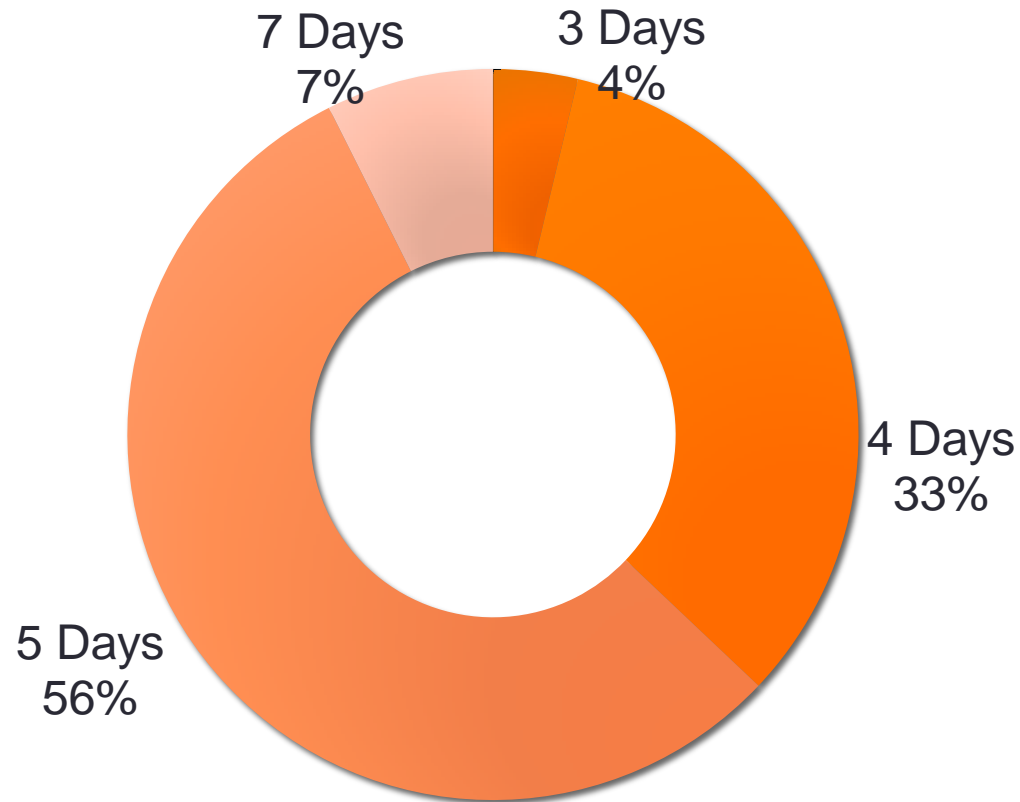

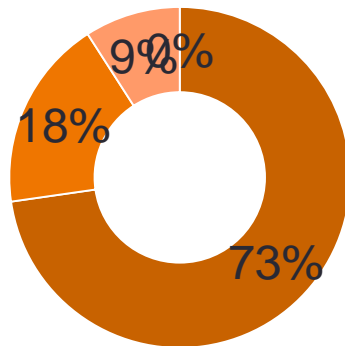
Only 25% keep their libraries open during the summer.



Percentage of libraries open



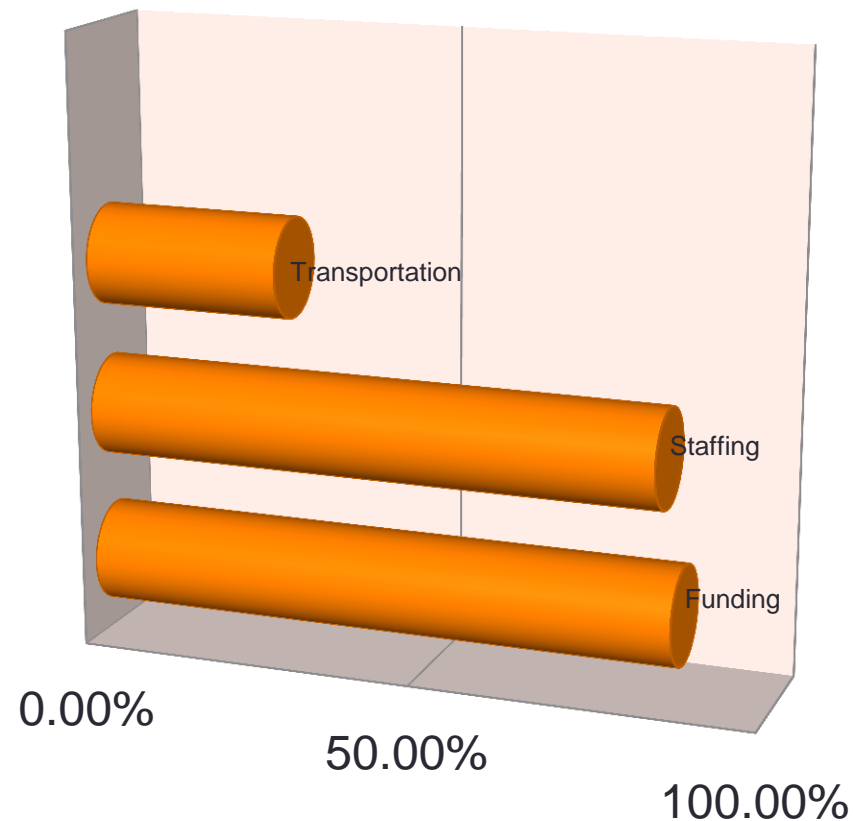
Number of Days the libraries are open

Potential SL3 Expansion

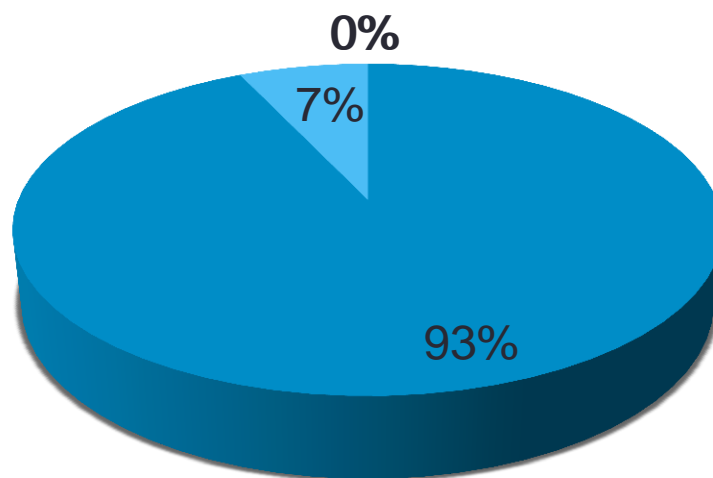
In the 69 sites, 86.8% responded that **lack of funding** is the cause of **library closures** in the summer, 84.2% due to **lack of staffing** and 28.9% cite **lack of transportation**.



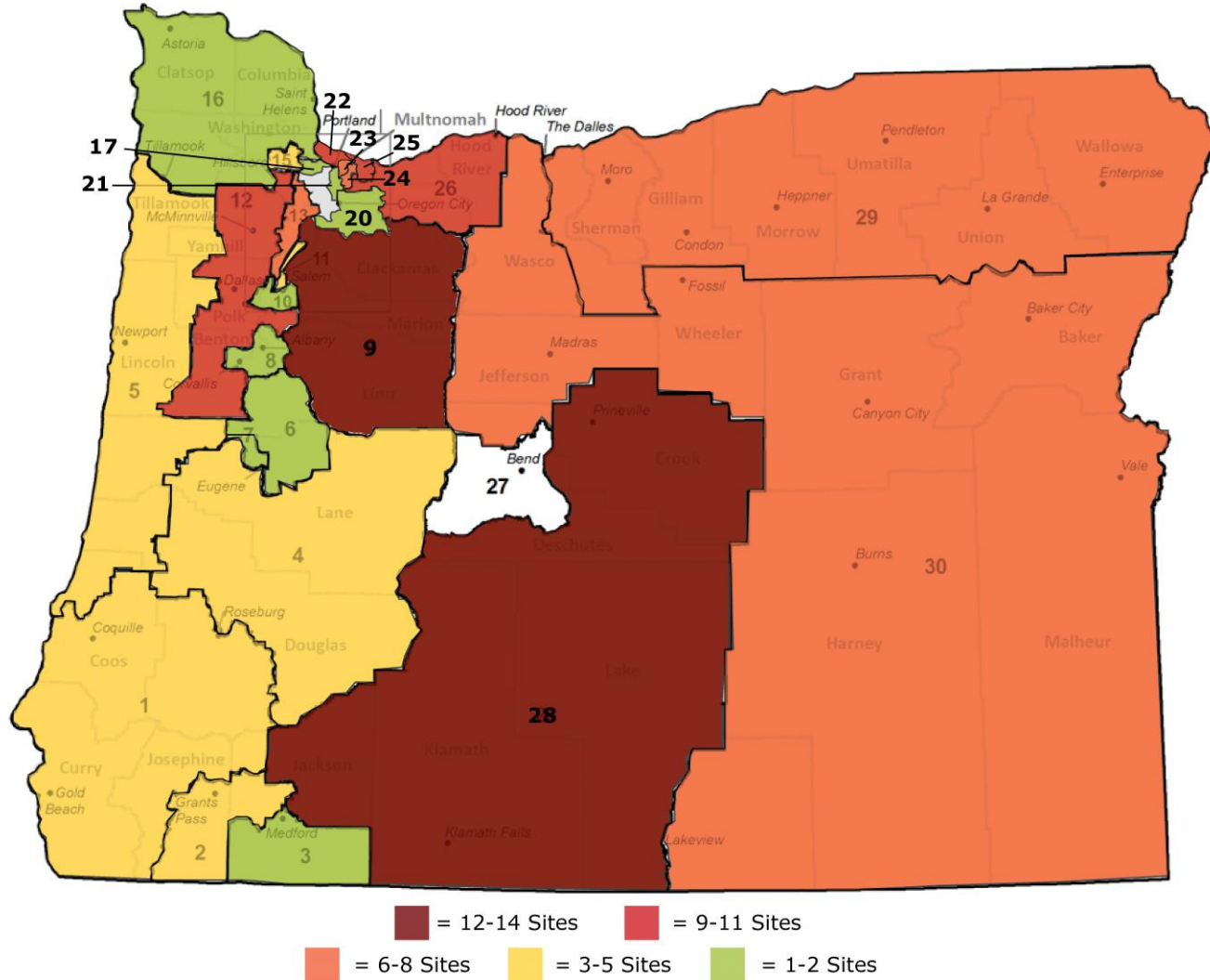
Potential SL3 Expansion
