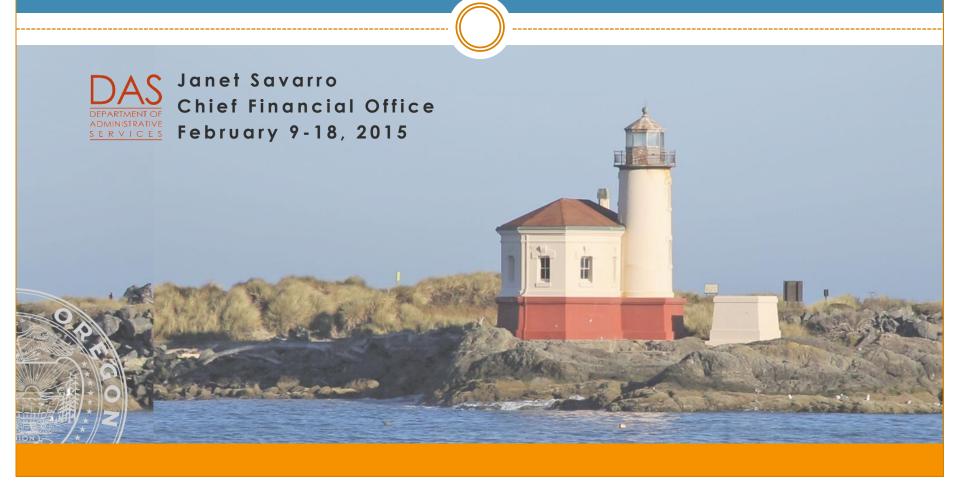

Department of Administrative Services Agency Overview



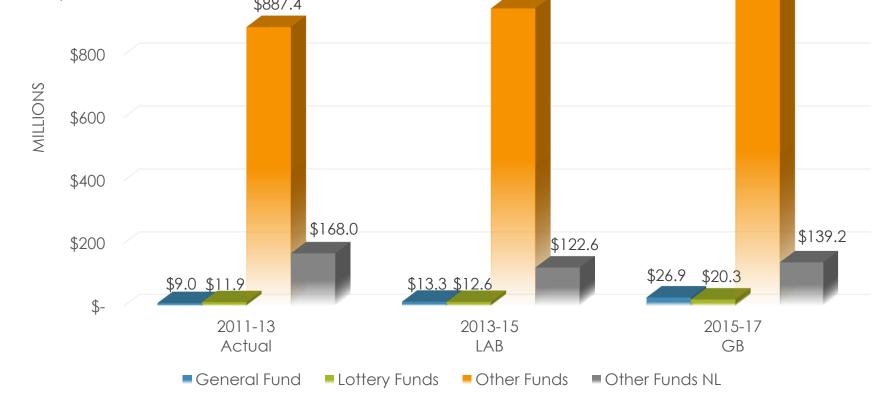


- Agency's emerging issues:

Department of Administrative Services Expenditure History + 2015-17 Governor's Budget







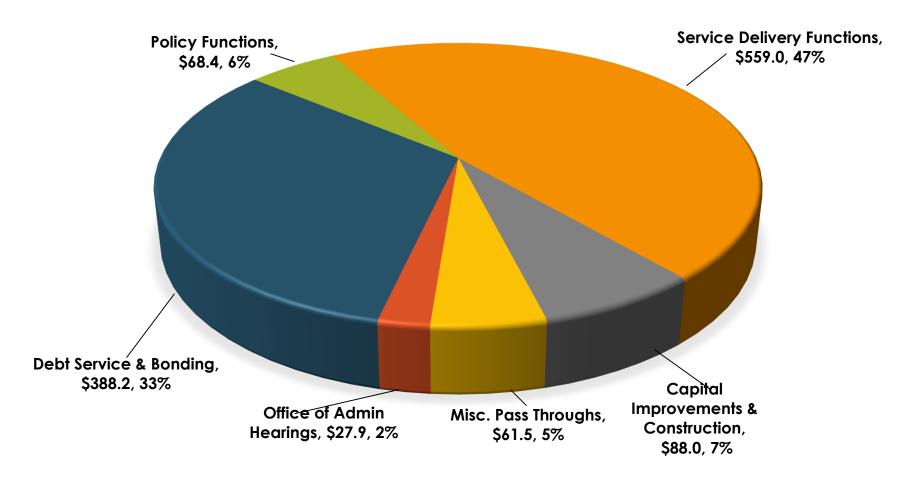

Other Funds



- Agency operating programs mostly funded with
 - Revenues come from other state agencies or local government customers
 - Collected as assessments for policy functions
 - Charged as fees for service delivery functions

Lottery Funds

 Lottery proceeds transferred to Economic Development Fund, Education Stability Fund, Parks and Natural Resources Fund and Oregon Education Fund

General Fund

 Used for funding of the Office of Economic Analysis, payment of debt service, and miscellaneous pass-through payments to non-governmental entities

Investments

- \$25.9 million Other Funds for acquisition of a new Human Resource Information System, 20 limited duration positions (20 FTE)
- \$2.0 million Other Funds for capital facility planning
- \$2.6 million Other Funds for strategic technology officers,
 12 permanent full-time positions (10.56 FTE)
- \$83.6 million Other Funds for capital construction projects
- \$27.9 million Other Funds for transfer of Office of Administrative Hearings, 111 positions (109.79 FTE)

Investments

- \$8.3 million General Fund for disposition of the Salem Hospital North campus property
- \$7.4 million General Fund for establishment of a Community Leverage Fund and public Infrastructure funding needs
- \$1.0 million General Fund for State Fair Council
- \$1.9 million General Fund for new bond debt service
