WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Repeals sunset provision related to authorized tribal police officers. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: In 2011, the Legislative Assembly passed Senate Bill 412, which provides tribal law enforcement officers in Oregon the same arrest and police powers as other state, local, and special police officers. At the time SB 412 was passed, a sunset provision was included.

Senate Bill 343 repeals the sunset provision contained in Senate Bill 412.
