Measure Description:

Makes Invasive Species Council appointment of State Invasive Species Coordinator mandatory.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Agriculture

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This bill would make the Invasive Species Council appointment of State Invasive Species Coordinator mandatory.

This position is contemplated in the Governor's Budget (\$141,329 GF) and funding was included in the budget. The Department has funded the position, in the past, with a combination of sources including, General Fund, Lottery Funds, Federal Funds, and Other Funds. The Department does not have an authorized position for the Coordinator and has contracted out the functions of this position.
