Senate Bill 336 with language from Senate Bill 338 added and amendments highlighted

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority to establish parity in funding formula for school-based health centers.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$952,000 \$900,000, which may be expended to establish parity in the funding formula for school-based health centers, the amount of \$900,000, which may be expended for planning and administration necessary to accommodate the development and establishment of new school-based health centers, and no less than \$97,000 to provide technical assistance in order to specifically address improving health equity and reducing disparities among youth by contracting with an entity that coordinates school-based health centers for the purpose of engaging organizations working with local communities.

SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.
