Measure Description:

Modifies number of circuit court judges in certain judicial districts.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Judicial Department

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure increases by one, the number of circuit court judges for Marion, Multnomah, and Washington counties. The measure includes a blank General Fund appropriation for the Judicial Department for salaries and benefits for the new judgeships and support staff.

This fiscal impact is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Judiciary Committee to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. A more complete fiscal analysis will be prepared as the bill is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
