**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Permits the Department of Transportation to renew or replace an out-of-state servicemember’s driver’s license without a photograph.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Provisions of measure

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Current law requires a photograph on a driver’s license, with only two permissive exceptions. Senate Bill 494 allows a third, narrow, permissive exception to the photograph requirement: only for renewal or replacement licenses, for servicemembers stationed outside of Oregon, who do not have an acceptable photograph on file with the Department of Transportation.
